Conditions we treat

Experienced and highly trained nurses at minor injuries units will treat a wide range of problems, that do not need a visit to A&E, such as:

- **Wounds** – cuts and bruises (including tetanus immunisation)
- **Bites** – human, insect and animal
- **Minor burns and scalds**
- **Muscle and joint injuries** – strains, sprains, limb fractures
- **Emergency contraception**
- **Eye problems** – infection/injury
- **Earache** (aged 2 years old and over)
- **Cystitis** (not male patients or children under 14 years)
- **Minor head injuries** (with no loss of consciousness).



Conditions we do not treat

Go to A&E or call 999

- Medical emergencies

Go to your GP

- Treatment for long standing conditions
- Routine wound re-dressing and removal of stitches
- Repeat prescriptions
- Travel vaccinations
- Medicals and sick certificates

Go to your dentist

- Dental problems
